Become LTC's 2012-13 WTCS State Ambassador!

What is the WTCS State Ambassador program? The Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) State Ambassador program recognizes outstanding student achievement in career and technical education and develops greater public awareness for Wisconsin's high quality technical education system.

How does the program work?

- One outstanding student from each of the 16 colleges in the WTCS is selected to represent his/her college for the 2012-13 school year.
- Students may be nominated by LTC faculty, management, or support staff; or they may self-nominate.
- All eligible nominees will be interviewed; one nominee will become LTC's 2012-13 WTCS State Ambassador.

Who is eligible to apply? Technical college students who have:

- Enrolled in a technical diploma or associate degree program.
- Completed at least one semester of study.
- The ability, flexibility and willingness to serve on campus during the 2012-13 school year.
- A genuine commitment to technical education and LTC.
- A strong work ethic and excellent communication skills; must be comfortable with public speaking.

What does the State Ambassador do?

- Commits to a one-year term (March 2012-February 2013).
- Attends the WTCS State Ambassador Conference in Madison on Wednesday and Thursday, April 18-19.
- Becomes a volunteer member of the LTC A-Team (campus student ambassadors).
- Represents LTC at campus, community, and WTCS events. Events vary each year, but may include:
 - New-Student Orientation
 - Commencement
 - Staff In-Service
 - Student Recruitment Events
 - Campus Open Houses
 - Visits with Legislators
 - Community Events
