#### ABOUT ITS

LTC's Individualized Technical Studies (ITS) associate degree is designed for working adults with unique backgrounds and educational needs that can't be met by the college's existing associate degree programs. ITS provides the option of creating your own degree. As an ITS student, you'll work with an occupational mentor of your choosing, an academic counselor/advisor, and college faculty to design an academically sound, student- and industry-specific program that incorporates your appropriate prior learning experiences.

#### **ADMISSIONS STEPS**

- Meet with program advisor/counselor to discuss educational plan options.
- Complete an assessment for placement (Accuplacer or ACT).
- Submit official transcripts (high school and other colleges).
- Submit application and \$30 fee.

#### **APPROXIMATE COSTS**

- \$132 per credit (resident)
- \$198 per credit (out-of-state resident)
- Credit for Prior Learning assessment
- Other fees vary by program (books, supplies, materials, tools, uniforms, health-related exams, etc.) Visit gotoltc.edu/financial-aid/tuition-and-fees for details.

#### **PLACEMENT SCORES**

Accuplacer/ACT scores will be used to develop your educational plan. Contact your program advisor/counselor for details.

#### **SPECIAL NOTE**

Curriculum varies depending upon the learner's individualized educational plan. Per the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS), 25 percent of coursework/credits must be completed from LTC and must be in the area of technical credits.

#### **UNIQUE REQUIREMENTS**

- Development of an individualized portfolio.
- · Selection of occupational mentor(s).
- Approval of the eduational plan by ITS Committee.
